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<p>Entry requirements</p>	<p>To participate in the exchange program, students need to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree program at their home institution. • be studying at a partner institution. • be recommended by their home institution. • have the basic knowledge and skills required for the classes they wish to take or research they plan to conduct at Kobe University. • complete the application form and all scanned documents are submitted by e-mail. <p>Those who want to conduct a research at Kobe University must obtain an agreement of acceptance from a supervisor at Kobe University before application. In this case, applicants should discuss their research plan with a prospective supervisor carefully.</p> <p>Students in undergraduate level are strongly encouraged to have enough familiarity with Japanese (N2 level in JLPT is recommended.)</p> <p>To those who want to study in the Department of Architecture, it is necessary to submit a certificate of Japanese and English Language proficiency, and also their portfolio.</p>
<p>Selection</p>	<p>Students are selected by application documents. Please note that not all applicants will be accepted as exchange students due to the limited capacity of Faculty, Graduate Schools, or Departments.</p> <p>Incomplete documents will not be processed. We will inform applicants of the result within 2 months after the application deadline.</p>

<p>Japanese course</p>	<p>Japanese Language Courses</p> <p>The Center for International Education (CIE) offers Japanese language courses for free for exchange students. Students who wish to take these courses are required to take the online level check test prior to the semester.</p> <p><Non-credit bearing courses></p> <p>*<u>Integrated Japanese Course</u> is open to all exchange students. *<u>Intensive Japanese Course</u> is developed for MEXT (Japanese government) scholarship students. Exchange students can be enrolled in this course on an availability basis only.</p> <p><Credit bearing course></p> <p>*<u>Japanese Language and Japanese Studies Course</u> (advanced level) is for undergraduate</p> <p>http://www.kisc.kobe-u.ac.jp/english/program/laboratory_course.html</p>
<p>Visa Application</p>	<p>Certificate of Eligibility (CoE)</p> <p>Kobe University applies for CoE on behalf of incoming students after the issuance of acceptance letter. The immigration process usually takes about 1 month. Upon successful issue of CoE, Kobe University sends the original acceptance letter and the CoE that are needed for visa application in student's home country.</p> <p>*A CoE is issued before a visa application by the immigration as evidence that the foreign national meets the conditions for landing in Japan. A foreign national who has a CoE can get a visa easier at an embassy or consulate within the standard processing period. Also landing permission will be given quickly if students show CoE to an immigration officer.</p> <hr/> <p>Visa</p> <p>The applicant must apply in person to an embassy or a consulate in their country. Visas cannot be obtained after arriving in Japan.</p>

<p>Insurance</p>	<p>【Compulsory】 National Health Insurance The National Health Insurance System in Japan is to reduce individuals' medical costs. International students who reside in Japan must become a member of the National Health Insurance scheme. Approximately 1,700 yen/ month *Payment is made in 10 installments for the period from June through March of the next year. http://www.city.kobe.lg.jp/life/support/insurance/img/28tirashiA_english.pdf</p> <hr/> <p>Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (PAS) Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research is a nation-wide mutual aid system for students to provide insurance for physical injuries caused by accidents during regular courses, official programs, and extracurricular activities on and off campus. 2	Curriculum Vitae	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free format
3	Academic Transcript	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The transcript must include the names of subjects you took, your school year, your scores, and the number of credits you earned. The evaluation method must be included in the transcript. • The transcript must be written in English, or if in another language, with translation into English or Japanese.
4	Certificate of Enrollment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Certificate of Enrollment must be written in English, or if in another language, with translation into English or Japanese.
5	Application for CoE	*Handwritten cannot be accepted. *Send in Excel format , not in PDF.
6	Financial Statement	The Financial Statement is a very important document for COE screening. Please submit the documents that will prove the "method of support to meet the expenses while in Japan (Section 26 of Application for COE)." Supporting documents may be: 1) The latest bank statement (a balance of more than 1,200,000 yen is required for a 1-year stay at Kobe University as an exchange student) and a copy of the latest bank passbook. or 2) A certificate of employment of your financial supporter plus a certificate of his/her annual income. or 3) A certificate of a scholarship.
7	ID photo data	ID photo data (JPG) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • without posted and taken within the past six months and upper-body included without hats and caps, (3 cm height and 2.4 cm width) <p>【CAUTION】The Immigration Bureau has strict regulations for submitting photos, so please be sure to carefully adhere to the specific guidelines for the size dimensions.</p>
